Teaching Opportunities

Fellows are expected to participate in teaching of medical students, residents, fellows, and even faculty. One is not “born” knowing how to teach; training in teaching skills is very important.

Fellows receive specific training, and practice preparing and presenting formal lectures, shorter less formal presentations, and small group discussions.

Fellows also are expected to lead inpatient attending rounds, after receiving extensive training.
